We exist to offer HOPE!

Caregivers (Flexible hours – one-time events to a few hours a week)

Drivers to provide rides to the elderly (62 and over) for medical appointments, grocery store, etc. 2 trips a month to several rides a week. You may select the rides you want to take based on your availability

Friendly Visits – Make phone calls to seniors or stop by to check in on them

One time help with special events such as Christmas Luncheon, Summer Picnic, Outings, Bingo, and Card/Board Games parties

Office (2-4 hour shifts available weekdays)

Receptionist – answer calls, give clients information about community resources, prepare files and mailings

Intake Counselors – meet one on one with clients to fill out a budget, assess needs and provide help with assistance such as utility bill shut-offs, toiletry items, vouchers for state id/license, work boots, and birth certificates

Office Maintenance – Cleaning, touch-up paint, handyman

Landscaping – grass cutting, flower planting, snow shoveling, weed pulling

Education & Development (Hours and Days Vary, Flexible)

Provide *Meals* or *Childcare* for classes. Childcare will focus on age-appropriate education curriculum. Coordinators also needed

Facilitators for Getting Ahead, GA While Getting Out, R Rules, Financial \$ense, Bridges Out of Poverty, and Parenting classes *Speakers & Facilitators* for small groups or workshops that will enrich the families or individuals

Tutors for all ages

Poverty Simulation Staffers, check-in and general volunteers

Mentors – long term & short term: Financial, Entrepreneur, for single-moms and their children

Resume Writing, Interviewing Skills, Job Readiness Skills, Soft Skills

Church connectors – volunteers that will work to connect the clients with church activities and other opportunities through relationship building by having a presence at Education & Development activities

Christmas Shop (Two-day evening event – 2-3 hr shifts, and the weeks before sorting toys & gifts, inventory)

Committee Members to meet once per month Sept-Jan to help plan

Toy & Gift Sorting, Personal Shoppers, Gift Wrappers

Preparing baskets of toiletry items

Shipping – helping carry items to car or volunteers to assist with moving items to and from the office

Tax Clinic – no exp. needed, free training, help prepare simple tax preparations for low-income families & seniors.

Christian Auto Repair (Held on Saturdays, 9 am-1:00 five times a year-you may do one or all 5)

Provide oil changes, tune-ups and minor repairs and to provide education on preventative car maintenance

Photographer/Videographer/Artists/Social Media/Website Design & Management (Hours and Days Vary)

Create materials for marketing – help us best share stories and thoughts of our clients to the greater community
